The SURF Foundation, a registered 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, has had a transformative year. In 2023, our efforts were bolstered by the generosity of donors, corporate partners, and the community, enabling us to support and expand our education, culture, and outreach programs. We also made significant progress with the launch of The Institute for Underground Science at SURF and the completion of the construction of the ethnobotanical garden, Čhangleška Wakĥán.

Our Education and Outreach team engaged nearly 18,000 K-12 students and 400 teachers through various initiatives, including field trips, science curriculum resources, and professional development workshops. # Čhangléška Wakĥán

One of the SURF Foundation's signature projects is Čhangleška Wakĥan, the ethnobotanical garden at SURF. Through the help of generous donors, the garden showcases our ability to collaborate with communities, colleagues, visitors, researchers, and other stakeholders. It is guided by the SURF Cultural Advisory Committee and the Čhangleška Wakĥan Working Group. Čhangleška Wakĥan aims to explore the connections between science, art, culture, and humanistic inquiry.

Construction of the garden was completed in November 2023, with programming set to begin in June 2024.


